You can see the percentage of points you shot on any stage or for the match by subtracting the number in parentheses from the total possible. Then divide that number by the total points possible. For example, Buddy Frazier shot SSP/SS in the match at 93.49... $215-14 = 201$ $201/215 = 93.49\%$. A good balance of speed and accuracy is 90 to 95%. If your score is higher, then you are shooting too slowly and should shoot faster; any less and you should slow down.
