Stage 1 – 6 targets 3 shots each.(6x3x5 = 90) Stage 2 – 4 targets, 3 shots each. (4x3x5 = 60)

Stage 3 – 7 targets, 1 shot each.(7x1x5 = 35) Stage 4 – 5 targets 3 shots each. (5x3x5 = 75)

Total: 90 + 60 + 35 + 75 = 260

Due to the rainstorm, we were unable to complete all the stages and therefore the percentages for the match will have to be calculated individually for each stage to determine your score's balance between speed and accuracy. Just use the total possible points for each stage that you shot and add them together, then subtract your number of points down from the total of those stages and that number divided by the total number of points possible. For example, Mike Robinette shot stages 2, 3 & 4 (60 + 35 + 75= 170 total possible points). He was down 44 points for those 3 stages. 170-44=126 170-44 = 126 divided by 170 = 74%. He should have shot more slowly to be more accurate.
