Steve Mahaney's score wasn't recorded by the score keeper for Stage 4. Shooters: Please make sure the score keeper has written down your time after you shoot. We try to get it done, but no one today is yet able to walk on water, maybe a frozen lake, but make sure your score is recorded.

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Stage 1: 4 targets, 2 shots; 2 targets, 3 shots; 1 steel, 1 shot =  $(4 \times 2 \times 5) + (2 \times 3 \times 5) + (1 \times 1 \times 5) = 75$

Stage 2: 4 targets, 2 shots; 2 steel, 1 shot =  $(4 \times 2 \times 5) + (2 \times 1 \times 5) = 50$

Stage 3: 5 targets, 2 shots; =  $(5 \times 2 \times 5) = 50$

Stage 4: 7 targets, 2 shots; 1 steel, 1 shot =  $(7 \times 2 \times 5) + (1 \times 1 \times 5) = 75$

Total:  $75 + 50 + 50 + 75 = 250$

You can see the percentage of points you shot on any stage or for the match by subtracting the number of points from the total possible for that stage or the match. Then divide that number by the total points possible. For example, **Bobby Rivera SSP / MA** in the match at 89.99%. That is  $250 - 27 = 223$ .  $223/250 = 89.2\%$ . A good balance of speed and accuracy is 90% to 95%. If your score is higher, then you are shooting too slowly, and should shoot faster. Any lower score than that, and you should shoot more slowly.

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Stage 1: 17 targets, 2 shots each =  $17 \times 5 \times 2 = 170$
